



Guatemala Mission Trip – Time Line/Checklist

Dates: Leaving Tuesday, January 24, and Returning, Wednesday, Feb 1, 2017

Location: We will fly into Guatemala City, Guatemala and travel to the mission field, about 3 hours away. This is where the team will stay for the majority of the trip.

Point of Contact in Guatemala: Robert Jackson is a missionary who has lived in Zacapa, Guatemala for the past 12 years. Robert is an American from the Reno, NV area and has been led into the mission field by the Lord. Scope of trip: We are flexible, but anticipate some work with Clean Water Projects, building projects, and feeding programs within the church. This will be further developed as Christwalk Team members commit to the mission.

Individual Expenses:

- Paid by you to the Airline or Government agency. These will need to be done by you:
 - Air fare – approximately \$650 (as of 11-1-16)
 - Passport cost - \$75 regular cost / \$135 expedited
 - Spending money - \$50-100 (suggested for final day)
 - Vaccinations (c.f., CDC website)
- Paid to Christwalk by either check, cash or credit card (on website):
 - Ground cost - \$450 (in country transportation, food, and housing)
 - **Note: - \$225 Deposit Due – December 1, 2016 - (refundable up to Dec 15, 2016)**

Christwalk participation requirements:

- Regular attendee / Church Member (suggested by not mandatory)
- Group involvement
- Volunteered in Christwalk Events
- Sharing Personal Testimony

What you need to do:

- First and foremost, begin, or continue praying about your involvement with this mission trip. If you are committed, and it is in His timing - God will make a way.
- Begin vaccinations – Specifically find out if you are current on needed vaccinations

- Begin Hep A and B immediately. Be aware that Malaria has a small “Pre” trip administration period.
- Begin the passport process ASAP.
- Bi-monthly communication with Group Leader - Doug – just to “check-in” with questions, comments, or concerns (on an as needed basis).
- *Important - please see flyer with guidelines on how to raise money for mission trip*
